These wines will be offered to guests upon arrival and will be promoted during the evening as the table wine.

*The Doolhof Cape Series comprises:*

The Cape Loerie is a delightful, easy-sipping Sauvignon Blanc. The Cape Robin Rosé is a Merlot/Pinotage rosé with abundant raspberry flavours and hints of Turkish Delight, while the Cape Boar is a lightly oaked blend in the Bordeaux style and the Cape Roan is also a lightly oaked blend with Shiraz dominating, in the style of the Rhône Valley.
